The Staff Housing Committee has met with Facilities Management and Dining Services Staff to get feedback from them.

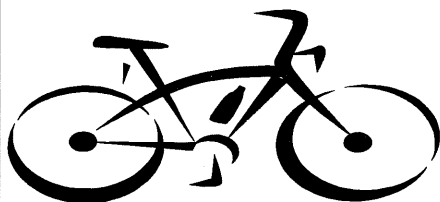
Additional town halls are planned for the near future including a special **Town Hall meeting about Staff Housing** which is planned to take place during Staff Celebration
