Staff Engagement Survey


Every two years the Council of UC Staff Assemblies partners with systemwide Human Resources to sponsor the Staff Engagement Survey. The goal is to assess the level of engagement at the individual UC locations and across the system. The campus will be provided the survey results and be able to compare the 2019 results to prior surveys on both the campus and system level. The survey vendor, Willis Towers Watson, will select a statistically-significant sample of policy-covered staff to invite to take the survey. 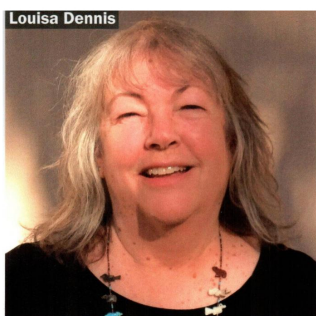
2019 Staff Service Milestone Reception
